Ward 5 South: Britannia

I pledge to renew efforts to streamline transfers, facilitate express routes to the Toronto subway system and keep fare prices affordable. I have a proven track record of getting things done!

• **Excessive speeding** on streets like Bristol Road have not been addressed. Many modifications can be made after conducting careful traffic studies and consulting with residents.

I pledge prompt responses to all complaints, full studies, consultation and innovative modifications through lane markings, parking allowances, bike channels and vigilant speeding enforcement. I have a proven record of getting things done!

Ward 5 North: Malton

A large part of Malton has been allowed to deteriorate and property values remain lower than the rest of the City. Much of Malton has been cut off from the development and progress the rest of Mississauga has enjoyed. Why is Malton, the very last of 42 Community Health Centres announced in 2004, only now being funded?

• **Malton needs a local office.** It is a 30 minute drive from City Hall. There must be a local, staffed office so that Malton's residents remain connected and well served by their Councillor. Parking problems, traffic at the Goreway rail crossing, substandard road and park maintenance and a desire for improved sports facilities like an outdoor stadium - residents must have a convenient location to express their concerns.

I pledge to open a constituency office in Malton and to ensure Malton's roads, streets and parks are up to the standards set in the rest of Mississauga. You have been neglected far too long! I'm tough, experienced and persistent and I have a proven track record for getting things done!

• **A crematorium** wouldn't be tolerated in a residential neighbourhood in any other ward in the City of Mississauga. It's shocking that the project has been allowed to get this far. All residents object to it and your new Councillor must ensure the City lawyers and planners fight any rezoning proposal at the Ontario Municipal Board.

I pledge to fight any rezoning application that would allow a crematorium to operate next to homes in the heart of Malton. I'm tough. I'm experienced and I have a proven track record of getting things done!

• **Goreway Drive needs a rail overpass.** The traffic congestion and air pollution caused by train delays must finally be addressed. Millions of dollars will be required from various levels of government. Long promised, the bridge must finally be delivered - now.

I pledge to start immediately to put together the needed funding and approvals to build the long-delayed Goreway Bridge. I got funding for the Mavis Road underpass when I was an MP. • **Malton businesses** need to be encouraged to form a Business Association to address infrastructure improvements, beautification of commercial areas, enforcement of property standards and marketing the Village of Malton as a great place to work and to shop.
