Carolyn Parrish Gets Things Done



Providing Dental Care for Low-Income Seniors

I'm proud of the dental care program I introduced for low-income seniors in Peel, one of only a few municipalities in Ontario to offer the care. The \$9-million program has given more than 7,000 seniors access to free, urgent dental care. To find out if you're eligible for the program, call Peel Public Health - 905.799.7700

Fundraising

I have raised over \$250,000 for the Mississauga Food Bank and \$750,000 for three successful Canada Day celebrations at City Hall . I know my goals for Ward 5 are achievable with funding from all levels of government, corporations and individuals in the community. I will keep costs low while delivering on my promises.



Saving You Money

Residents saved \$3-million in a single year after I put crumbling sound walls on the federal infrastructure grant program. Before I lobbied for the change, homeowners were on the hook for half the cost. Sound walls are now replaced under City maintenance budgets.

Better Housing Options for Mississauga

I brought Mississauga its first affordable rental high rise in more than 10 years. Land was donated by the City and developers, and I obtained provincial and federal housing grants for the completion of this 250-unit project for seniors and families.



Planning Efficient Cities

Taxpayers have saved millions of dollars each year since I initiated a study into duplicate planning services between the Region of Peel and the City of Mississauga. Now Cities have taken over the lion's share of planning within their own boundaries.

Creating Public Space

Public buildings should not sit empty; there is always need for more public space and services in the city. I negotiated a land exchange between the Peel District School Board and the City of Mississauga to develop a modern, bright library attached to one of the City's oldest schools. The facility is used by students and the public, and has adult and seniors' programs.



Representing Canada

As a Member of Parliament with Prime Minister Chretien for 13 years, I was elected Chair of the 103-member Ontario Caucus in Ottawa and I was the first female Vice Chair of the NATO Parliamentary Association in Brussels. During my time with NATO, I travelled as Parliamentary representative throughout the Middle East, Pakistan, Bosnia, Ukraine and other emerging democracies.

Improving Traffic

As a Mississauga Member of Parliament I got traffic moving on Mavis by securing federal infrastructure money. The rail crossing is now an attractive and efficient overpass, keeping traffic flowing.





Its Time for Action

I Will Have Malton Declared A Community Improvement District

Under this designation the Village of Malton will receive special funding and attention with a team of City Planners looking at the condition and potential of every road, neighborhood, vacant lot and commercial/industrial property. In consultation with business and residents, proposed improvements will be fast-tracked and the Village will be re-energized.



I Will Get Traffic Moving Again

Traffic congestion throughout the city is in an outrageous state and there's no easy or quick solution. Bike lanes appear random, inconsistent, and confuse drivers. Only 10% of the population in our city uses public transit leaving our roads clogged and congested at rush hour. Transit is slow, expensive and doesn't connect quickly with the TTC or the airport. 750,000 residents pay taxes to the province. We must demand our own subway link.



I Will Develop Private-Public Partnerships for Important Projects

Having personally raised over \$1 million for worthy causes, I intend to attract City funds, provincial/federal grants and private investment throughout Ward 5: a Heritage Park for Britannia, a Cricket Stadium on city lands, a Food Terminal on the vacated Magellan Aerospace property and the incredibly overdue Goreway Bridge.



I Will Rejuvenate Wildwood Park

The park's trees have been devastated by insect infestation. The arena and associated facilities are substandard. Re-planting is just a start. Superior facilities such as a first-rate playground, sports fields and other amenities are owed to the community. City funding, provincial grants and private sector investment will create a park of which we can all be proud...and it's time Malton celebrated Canada Day with a giant fireworks display!

I Will Act on Housing and Taxes

City Council must address the serious shortage of affordable housing throughout the city. Of 33,000 "illegal" apartments, the new by-laws imposed by the City resulted in only 2 registrations.

This must be reviewed right away. With the airport and the huge industrial base, 75% of the City's industrial tax comes from Ward 5. These dollars must be spent wisely and more importantly, we must ensure a fair share is being reinvested in the Ward 5 community.



I Will Help Preserve the Britannia Farm

This gorgeous 200 acre property on Hurontario was a clergy reserve left to the Peel District School Board for the benefit of the children of Peel. Working with the Board, I am committed to raising the millions of dollars required to preserve those acres as a lush, green park for educational and passive recreational purposes - for all time. I have the first pledge in my pocket already!
